



Junior Secretary Volunteer Vacancy

Irish Squash is seeking to appoint a Junior Secretary who will focus on the promotion and development of junior squash. This is a pivotal volunteer role that requires an in-depth understanding of the game, as well as the challenges and opportunities for junior squash across the island of Ireland.

Key Responsibilities

- Chair the Junior Committee, which consists of the four provincial Junior Secretaries.
- Make recommendations to the CEO regarding the development and promotion of junior tournaments.
- Make recommendations regarding the junior events calendar.
- Support tournament directors to elevate the standard of junior tournaments, enhancing the experience for young players and ensuring they are retained in the game.
- Address any issues that may arise and refer these to the CEO as required.
- Provide input into a Competitions Committee to ensure alignment across all Irish Squash events and to raise the standard of events across the island of Ireland.
- Support the delivery of the Irish Squash Junior Open and other marquee tournaments for junior players.
- Coordinate junior representative teams, including the review of selection criteria, selection of teams, and team managers.

The volunteer role requires a time commitment of approximately 1-3+ hours per week and will be supported by a member of staff.
